


Dear Jeter,



children are my favorite people. I would enjoy coming to your class more often, unfortunately, I have so many things to do and so little time, that it is hard to get to each class as often as I would like each week.



I am 3 years old and my birthday is on January 8. When I am at home, I enjoy the backyard and chasing birds and squirrels. I am quick and I know I
